



Team Member Expectations Agreement

Our goal at Naked Apple Tribe is to encourage, support, and build up the homeschool family. Having a team with fair and firm expectations is one of the ways that Naked Apple achieves this goal. Below you will find expectations, with biblical reasonings, that our team members agree to uphold:

- I am a role model for the rest of the group by my words and actions. (Titus 2:7-8)
- I will attend Quarterly team meetings; I will inform the Board President, as soon as possible, about meetings I am unable to attend. (James 5:12)
- I will maintain enrollment of at least one child in Naked Apple Tribe Co-op while serving on the Naked Apple Team. If I do not have any children enrolled, I will resign my position. (Ecclesiastes 3:1)
- I will conduct myself with integrity and I shall refrain from gossiping about Naked Apple Tribe Leaders. I will show support and backing for the Leadership Team to other Tribe members. If a member has an issue with Naked Apple Tribe or Leadership, I will encourage them to speak directly to the Leadership Team rather than gossiping with other members. (Ephesians 4:29)
- I will keep all Naked Apple Tribe information confidential. This includes, but is not limited to, Leadership meeting discussions, private meetings with other co-op members, or any other sensitive information that would be harmful to Naked Apple Tribe if shared outside the Leadership Team. (Proverbs 11:13)
- I will be open to gentle rebuke or correction from other Leaders. (Proverbs 15:31-32)
- I will resolve conflicts biblically and treat others with respect and kindness. (Matthew 18:15-17)
- I will complete tasks assigned to me in a timely fashion, and ask for help when needed. (Matthew 5:37)
- I understand that everything I do or decide should be done for the benefit of the Tribe, not my own interests. (Philippians 2:3-4)
- I have read and understand all Naked Apple Policies and agree to abide by them. (Romans 13:1-2)
