



Lead Teacher Responsibilities

A Lead Teacher at Naked Apple Tribe should be a person who is humble (emphasizes team over self and is quick to point the contributions of others), hungry (self-motivated, diligent, and prioritizes the organization's needs), smart (good judgment around diverse people groups, socially appropriate, and aware of the impact of their words and actions).

Qualifications:

- Attention to detail, Strong communication skills and the ability to organize and prioritize tasks.
- Sound judgment and ability to navigate diverse situations.
- Collaborative mindset and ability to work closely with the director and other team members.
- Demonstrated capacity for making informed decisions and managing diverse situations.
- Flexibility to adapt to changing needs and schedules.

Responsibilities:

- Support for Parents:
 - assists in advocating for the teachers of the co-op. This person will make sure that the teachers of co-op have a voice in procedures and policies at Naked Apple.
 - Assist parents in structuring their class for the year.
 - Provide guidance in selecting curriculum, developing lesson plans, and addressing any teaching-related challenges.
 - assists grade lead teachers in giving direction to the classes within her age group.
 - will meet with the grade lead teachers at least once a semester to discuss any classroom concerns and best practices for educating that age group.
- Curriculum Approval:
 - Oversees the Curriculum Coordinator in approving curriculum submitted by parent teachers, ensuring alignment with Naked Apple guidelines.

The Lead Teacher plays a crucial role in advocating and supporting the teacher community at Naked Apple and maintaining the quality and consistency of our educational programs.
