



Chapel Coordinator Roles and Responsibilities

A Chapel Coordinator at Naked Apple Tribe should be a person who is humble (emphasizes team over self and is quick to point the contributions of others), hungry (self-motivated, diligent, and prioritizes the organization's needs), smart (good judgment around diverse people groups, socially appropriate, and aware of the impact of their words and actions).

Qualifications:

- Devoted to teaching the Word to those around them.
- Ability to work with others towards the common goal of supporting the homeschool community.
- Strong communication skills and the ability to organize and prioritize tasks effectively.

Responsibilities:

- Co-op Day Leadership
 - Arrange Chapel Speakers and manage sign-ups for chapel sessions.
 - Manages Chapel Games Coordinator
 - Supervises Chapel Worship in coordination with the worship leader.
- Administrative Responsibilities
 - Designs Chapel Flow.
 - Build and maintain Chapel speaker sign up.
 - Creates any slides necessary to Chapel time.
